Below we have outlined where we plan to spend Sports Funding this academic year.

Activity/Focus	Aim	Cost	Impact
Specialist PE teacher from local High School employed for 1 day a week.	The aim is to work with and alongside teachers to develop their skills and understanding of a range of sports. It will also strengthen links with High School and hope to increase participation in extra-curricular sports at Millfields and, in the longer term, Malbank.	£150 x 39 weeks = £5850	
Specialist Multi-skills/Gymnastics/Cheerleading teacher employed 1 day a week	Premier Sports will provide a teacher to work alongside class teachers and TAs to develop their knowledge and understanding of PE. Reception – Y4 will be targeted to develop teachers, mainly in multi-skills, gymnastics and cheerleading. Lunchtime club to target children who need additional intervention or activity.	£105 per day x 37 weeks £3,905	
After School Activities Co-ordinator	To provide a wider range of clubs for children. To encourage all children to be involved in after school clubs, activities and competitions.	£520	

Membership of the Crewe/Nantwich Sports Partnership	To encourage and enable more children to compete on an inter school basis.	£750	
Playground equipment purchased	To encourage and promote physical activity at playtime/lunchtime	£1000	
PE Resources purchased	To increase the range of sports available to teachers and pupils during PE lessons	£1000	
Teacher/TA released from class to teach PE 1 afternoon per week.	To develop skills in PE and to move children to taking part in extracurricular sport both in school and beyond. As part of this drive, outside agencies will be brought in to support the teaching.	£1560 for HLTA to teach Lead teacher's class
