<p>Specialist PE teacher from local High School employed for 1 day a week.</p>	<p>After the success of this arrangement in 2017/18, we are continuing with the Malbank teacher. They will support with curriculum planning, assessment and development. In addition, teachers work alongside and support teachers who will teach follow up lessons in a range of PE areas, including Sports, Dance and Orienteering.</p>	<p>£160 x 39 weeks = £6240</p>	
<p>Specialist Multi-skills/Gymnastics/Cherleading teacher employed 1 day a week</p>	<p>Premier Sports will provide a teacher to work alongside class teachers and TAs to develop their knowledge and understanding of PE. Teachers work alongside the teacher and teach a follow up lesson based on the team teach lesson.</p> <p>Extra-curricular club targeting children to promote engagement, health and wellbeing. Different groups will be targeted each term with parental meetings following the club to encourage future engagement.</p>	<p>£110 per day x 37 weeks = £4,070</p> <p>£30 x 37 weeks = 1,110</p>

Develop the outdoor playground/play areas	Maintain and develop the outdoor play areas to ensure all equipment is suitable for year round use. Develop a timetable to ensure all children have access to the areas throughout the week, including curriculum time.	£1,010
