 - off-site sporting fixtures outside the school day
- The school will inform you about each trip or activity before it takes place.
- You can, if you wish, tell the school that you do not want your child to take part in any particular school trip or activity.
- Written parental consent will not be requested from you for the majority of off-site activities offered by the school – for example, year-group visits to local amenities – as such activities are part of the school’s curriculum and usually take place during the normal school day.
- At Millfields Primary School, we provide access to the Internet through an approved service provider. The service provider monitors and filters the sites available, to control the materials and the language available to children.
- Photographs that are used on our school website will not include the children’s names.

Millfields Primary School Responsible Internet Use Agreement

At Millfields Primary School, we provide access to the Internet through an approved service provider. The service provider monitors and filters the sites available, to control the materials and the language available to children. As with any electronic monitoring system we do not have total control and have therefore put into place the following rules to further protect the safety of children using the Internet.

- Pupils must ask permission to use the Internet and may do so only in the presence of an adult.
- Pupils are expected to be responsible for their own behaviour on the Internet, just as they would in any area of the school. This includes the materials they choose to access and the language they use.
- Pupils are not expected to deliberately seek out sites that could cause offence. Should pupils accidentally encounter such materials or receive mail that causes concern, they should report this immediately to a teacher. Our service provider will be notified to block this content in the future if deemed necessary.
- The school have the right to check pupil's files and monitor sites that have been visited **on school equipment** both inside and outside the school boundaries.
- Pupils should not give out personal information about themselves or others, pictures or the name and location of the school, unless part of an agreed school project.
- Pupils should only use the school's computer for work related to school.
- Pupils must not use CD-ROMs, USB Keys, floppy discs or other forms of media from outside school without permission.
